“Help for Today”
August 15th 2021 – July 31, 2022

The homeless population is on the rise in the Illinois Valley.
Clients stayed in a  a total of **13,926** times so far this season.

It takes a lot of food to  serve **371** clients, of which **56** are children. IV PADS staff and volunteers served **41,072**  meals in 10 months.

What do clients do at the shelter besides eat and sleep? They take classes, obtain life skills, and receive case management.

Your donations matter!

 Management, Job Seekers,  101, and Reflections Classes were attended **288** times.

 Transportation of clients to medical or legal appointments happened **403** times.

Staff worked on life skills to help clients achieve self-sufficiency a total of **6313** times.
That’s a lot of life skills!

SUCCESS: 145 new jobs were obtained!

1446 clothing    items were provided to clients. This includes outerwear, interview attire, shoes, and clothing for clients to use as they start new jobs.

1380 household items, such as furniture,  small appliances, towels, and other home essentials were provided to shelter guests as they obtained new homes.




65 new  homes were found.

A majority of these donations are directly from donors who support our **Lily Pads Resale Boutiques** in Peru and Ottawa.
